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## New Business

### Minimum Wage Increase

The district approved a minimum wage for all employees to be \$12.30 per hour. Minimum wage in Missouri was increased to \$12.30 per hour on January 1. All employee who make less than \$12.30 will see their hourly rate increased to \$12.30.

Mowing Bids

The district approved Kroencke Landscaping to a three year mowing contract. The total cost is \$2,075 per mow in the first year.

High School Commons Floor Bids

The district approved removing the carpet in the high school commons and replacing the carpet with epoxy flooring in the areas where students eat. The carpet will remain in the auditorium section of the cafeteria. The total cost to replace the carpet and install epoxy flooring is \$46,600. The replacement will occur this summer.
