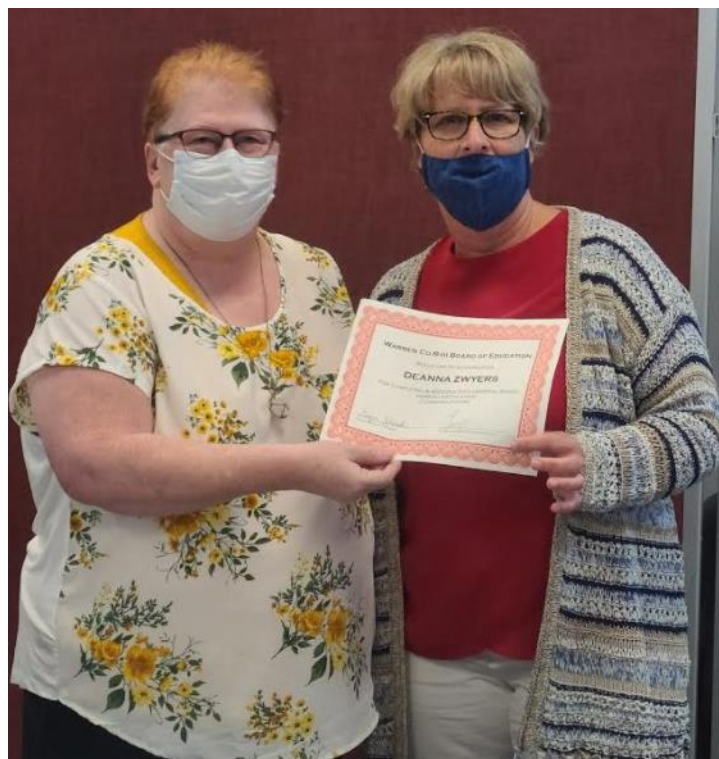
Below is information from the June 10, 2021 Warren County R-III School Board meeting.

New Hires

Old Business

Form JEA-AF1 (Part Time Attendance Form), form IKFA-AF1 (Early Graduation Form), Policy IKFA (Early Graduation) were approved. These policies now outline which activities early graduates can still participate in.

New Business

New curriculum for library media, computers, business, marketing, industrial technology, FACS, agriculture, Project Lead the Way, math, english language arts, visual arts, and music were approved.

A contract with Integrated Facility Services was approved for the purpose of adding a water flow control device on the Daniel Boone HVAC unit. This should provide better temperature control in the building. This device is being paid for out of federal ESSER II funds.

An agreement with the City of Warrenton was approved to maintain our current level of School Resource Officers. The expense of the school resource officers is split 50/50 between the school district and the city of Warrenton.

Base substitute teacher pay has been increased to \$120 per day which is equal to \$15 per hour.
