All students participating in the free meal program also qualify for free breakfast.

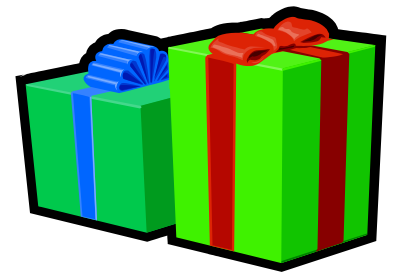
Breakfast is \$.30 for students participating in the reduced meal program.
