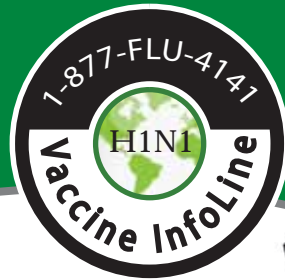

Did You Know

The H1N1 vaccine program is a massive and challenging undertaking, but the vaccine is still the best protection against the H1N1 flu.

Pregnant women, children and young adults are the most at risk of contracting the H1N1 flu. Therefore, those groups will be given priority in receiving the vaccine first.

Studies indicate that older persons appear to be at less risk for H1N1 flu because of some degree of pre-existing resistance to the virus.
