Scholarship Program

Eligibility Rules and Application Procedures

The Marthasville Area Chamber of Commerce will award 2 scholarships annually of \$1000.00 each. The Marthasville Area Chamber Scholarship Committee will review all applications and will select qualified recipients.

To be eligible for a scholarship award, candidates:

- a. Must live within the southern Warren County zip codes of 63357 or 63342.
- b. At the time of application must be at least a senior in high school.
- c. Must pledge to use any scholarship money awarded toward undergraduate college studies. Scholarships may be used by the recipients to pay tuitions, room and board fees, books and other related costs to their undergraduate college studies.
- d. Must be a full time student carrying a minimum of 12-hour credits or more per semester.

The Marthasville Area Chamber Scholarship Committee reserves the right to investigate and verify any information or data submitted by the candidate.

Applications for a scholarship will be made available during the months of February and March.

All Applications **MUST** be postmarked by 4:00p.m. April 15.

All recipients will be notified by mail by the last week of April.

All recipients will be invited to the May meeting of the Marthasville Area Chamber to receive their awards.
