Meeting Minutes

A. Focus

The focus of the meeting was to debrief the data requested.

- Comparative Districts- looked at single MAP index scores and the configuration of said districts
- How many buildings are in “level 4, restructuring planning” – Only buildings that receive Title 1 funds are classified as level 4, restructuring planning - others are classified as school improvement level 4
 - 2,099 buildings in Missouri, 65 are level 4, restructuring planning, 10 of the 65 are feeder schools, and 78 total feeder schools in Missouri(k-2)
- Percentage of staff at Daniel Boone and Warrior Ridge that have been in district more than 4 years - Daniel Boone 74.3% Warrior Ridge 65.6%
- Building Capacity – Each elementary building can hold approximately 500 students
- Cost of retrofit existing buildings to K-5 - Estimate approximately \$50,000 to retrofit restrooms and drinking fountains in the 3 elementary buildings

B. Objective

The objective was small group collaboration. Divide into groups of 6 and choose top 5 reasons for restructuring. Consensus was reached that these are the top five reasons.

- Student Achievement
- Pre- K implementation
- Communication between teachers, schools and the community/parents
- Relationships between students, staff, parents and community
- High Quality Instruction/Professional Development increase and continued

C. Data Requested

- Compare schools with similar configuration as us to schools that offer Pre-K
- Review the data of any size district without the growth model
- Possible grade level configurations

Focus for next meeting will be to use the top 5 factors and choose our path.
