# Sight Words

It is very important in the lower grades especially, that students know and recognize basic sight words. These sight words are the most frequently used words in language and reading at each grade level. Research has shown that students who have working knowledge of these sight words read at higher levels and with greater fluency. Please work on helping your child master these sight words (make flash cards for the car, look for these words in stories, or practice reading the list each night before bed). Once your child knows his/her entire list there is a special recognition here at school!
