Students and Parents:

Summer school is approaching quickly and we wanted to remind you of some important information pertaining to the high school summer school program.

Students are required to be at school from 7:00 a.m. until noon, Monday through Friday for all physical education, world history and credit recovery classes. Summer school will start on Tuesday, June 1st, and end on Friday, July 2nd. Transportation will not be provided. Breakfast and lunch will not be provided. We encourage students to bring a snack with them because there will be a 5-10 minute break every day. No incentive programs will be tied to school summer this year, like in years past.

In order to earn credit, students must participate fully and be present. Attendance is extremely important in an accelerated program like summer school. Therefore, students can only miss one day of school per semester, or 2 for the entire summer school session. If students have discipline issues at school, they will conference with an administrator and if problems continue, they will be sent home for the remainder of the summer and therefore not earn credit.

Attached to this letter you will find the medical authorization form for summer school. Please fill this out and have your child return it the first day of summer school to the high school office.
