

Tim and Jan Long Leadership Award

The Tim and Jan Long award recognizes a deserving high school senior in the service area of Family Health Care of Marthasville. This award is given in the spirit of the many men and women who were leaders in the Marthasville Community who helped Dr. Long establish his medical practice in Marthasville in 1981.

This scholarship provides a \$2500 one-time educational grant to a deserving student to further his or her education. This grant will be for educational expenses, tuition, books, and fees. It is not renewable on an annual basis to the same student.

The student should:

- 1) Be a leader in school and community
- 2) Have a record of service to his or her school and local/world community
- 3) Have exceptional academic credentials

Application:

Please send a completed application to Marthasville Area Chamber of Commerce and include:

- 1) Your high school transcript
- 2) A one-page essay describing your leadership service to your community and your aspirations for the future

Eligibility for the award:

- 1) Definition of a service area. The student given this grant should reside in the Marthasville area within the following zip codes: Marthasville 63357, Treloar 63378, Concord Hill 63357, Augusta 63332, Dutzow 63342, and Warrenton 63383
- 2) Selection process: The selection will be made by a representative of the Marthasville Chamber of Commerce, a member of the Marthasville office staff and a member of the Patients First Health Care Foundations with input from a representative of the Tim and Jan Long family.
