Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Summer Quest Program?

The Warren County R-III Summer Quest is the extended-learning summer program operated by the Warren County R-III School District to provide a quality educational experience to the students of the district.

What is the cost of the Summer Quest program?

The Summer Quest Program is free to all students.

When will the program be held?

The program will operate daily beginning June 4 and ending July 2, 2009, 7:45 a.m. to 2:35 p.m. Changes will be announced.

Must my child be in attendance every hour of the program in order to receive credit for the Summer Quest program?

No. It is assumed that students may have vacations or camps planned. While prizes for good attendance are available to students, a child's occasional absence should not deter parents from enrolling their children in the program.

Will transportation be provided to and from the program?

Yes, transportation will be provided for those student families who qualify for transportation during the regular school year. However, bus routes may vary from the routes during the regular school year. Transportation information will be sent to those families who require transportation as soon as the plan becomes available.

How does the incentive program work for K-8?

Student prizes are dependent on attendance.

\$100 Shopping Card will be issued for perfect attendance - 0 hours missed.

\$75 Shopping Card will be issued for near perfect attendance - Up to 6.5 hours missed (one day).

\$50 Shopping Card will be issued for attendance that does not exceed 13 hours missed (two days).

All student attendance prizes will be presented as Wal-Mart gift cards. The attendance prizes are contingent on actual (full-day) attendance in the Summer Quest program.

Daily prizes will also be awarded to students on the basis of good attitude and achievement as determined by each site

Will breakfast/lunch be served each day?

Yes, students will be served using the same systems used during the regular school year. Students should plan to purchase or bring meals in the same manner they do during the regular school year.

Lunch for grades K-5 will cost \$2.05.

Breakfast for grades K-5 will cost \$1.45.

Lunch for grades 6-8 will cost \$2.15.

Breakfast for grades 6-8 will cost \$1.45.

All reduced lunches will cost \$0.40.

All reduced breakfasts will cost \$0.30.
