High School Principal and Director of Accounting among new hires

Included on the list of new hires by the Board of Education are Mrs. Julie Corrigan as the new Director of Accounting and Dr. Brad Ross as principal of Warrenton High School.

Mrs. Corrigan, who was approved as the new Director of Accounting, comes to Warren County R-III from TVS Supply Chain Solutions of North America, where she has served as Accounting Manager since 2014. She will start with the district on May 18, 2020.

Dr. Ross will transition from his current role to that of high school principal effective July 1, 2020. He has been an assistant principal at Black Hawk Middle School for four years, and has with the district since 2001.

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Superintendent Reports:

Dr. Klinginsmith presented the financial report, building updates, and an update on the Food Distribution Program. All of these reports are available for viewing on [BoardDocs](#).

Contract Approvals:

The following contracts were approved by the Board of Education:

- SISFIN contract for open enrollment. This will allow us to do parts of the student enrollment process virtually. The total cost is \$640, which falls within the current budget parameters.
- Tech Electronic Service Agreement. This is for monitoring the Rebecca Boone fire alarm system. This is being removed from the Black Hawk Middle School panel and making it a stand-alone system. Total cost is \$2,736.31. This falls within the current budget parameters.
- Concrete Repair. This contract is for concrete repair around the district. Sieve Contractors was the low bid at \$14,200, which falls within the current budget parameters.
- Canvas. This will enable the district to see how long students watch videos and gives the ability to chunk videos for instructional purposes. This is for a total of \$5,512 and will be paid out of Title IV funds. This falls within the current budget parameters.

New Business:

- Capstone/OSBA was approved as the new district health insurance provider as of July 1, 2020. Details of the plan are available for viewing on [BoardDocs](#).
- Surplus of Surplus Personal Protection Equipment. The board voted to donate part of the surplus hand sanitizer to the Warrenton Post Office and all other surplussed healthcare related personal protection equipment to the local BJC and SSM donation locations.
- Director of Accounting Position: The new Director of Accounting position was approved. This replaces the Director of Finance position.
- Facility Closures. All district facilities will be closed until further notice. This includes Central Office, the Faculty Workout Room, and Playgrounds.
