Dear Staff,

I wanted to update you on our local Care to Learn Chapter and what type of services we've been able to provide for students so far this year.

August 2016 from Wal-Mart: \$1141.53 helped 904 students
September 2016 from Wal-Mart: \$711.25 helped 69 students
October 2016 from Wal-Mart: \$523.21 helped 110 students
November 2016 from Wal-Mart: \$890.27 helped 26 students
December 2016 from Wal-Mart: \$479.40 helped 107 students

The items we purchase at WalMart include clothing, food, hygiene items, and prescriptions.

We have paid Biermann Eye Health \$ 408.50 for three students glasses.

Within the district each building's food service department has an account to pay for breakfast and lunch for any child who needs it. During the first month of having this account in place, we paid \$804.30 and the second month we paid \$949.40.

Grand total so far for the first semester we have spent: \$5,907.86 on our students.

Our current fundraiser is the Shoe Drive that Tonya McDaniel is heading up at WHS-thank you to Tonya and the other high school counselors who have helped her to count and bag shoes!
