Below is information from the April 28, 2022 Warren County R-III School Board meeting.

#### **Board Goals**

The board of education has set the following goals for the 22-23 school year.

### Goal #1: Develop a Culture of Success

- Through surveying data collected from a variety of stakeholders analyze the results of the question: "How would you
  rate the Warren County R-III School District?"
- · Include celebrations each month at regular board meetings
- The Warren County R-III School District will increase A+ eligibility rate by 3% over the CSIP cycle. (encompasses 95% attendance, 2.5 GPA, proficient in Algebra 1 EOC, 50 hours of tutoring, good citizenship)
- 75% of all students in grades K-8 will be reading on or above grade level, or have achieved one years worth of reading growth per year, over the CSIP cycle

## Goal #2: Address our Financial Future

- · Meet regularly with the county and city government to calibrate growth forecasts
- Keep ending fund balances above 25%
- · Quarterly updates on capital project budget

#### Goal #3: Develop and Retain Staff

- · Staff will be retained at 90% annually
- Develop a teacher leadership program for those that are interested in taking on leadership opportunities outside the classroom
- · Develop a future teachers program for students
