Superintendent Reports

Dr. Klinginsmith gave updates about communication, COVID, and the district finances. The district spent \$998,271 less than was spent last year. The total decrease in spending over the last two years is \$1,818,655. The district's ending fund balance for the 20-21 school year is 20.31%.

A new position was approved to coordinate serving dinner to all students. All students will be able to receive a free dinner on school days. More information will be sent out once this position is filled. This position and the food needed is reimbursable and should not be an additional expense to the district. Students will now be able to receive a free breakfast, lunch, and dinner for next school year.

Improvements to the security of the Black Hawk Middle School/ Daniel Boone Campus and the High School were approved. New exterior locks will be installed on all doors. Electronic fobs will be used to enter the building instead of physical keys. For those renting facilities, they will need to have a fob checked out to them once they are available.
