- The district approved a contract for new cabinetry in the Daniel Boone workroom for a total of \$4,381.

Budget Amendment #2

Budget Amendment #2 was approved. This budget amendment estimates the district to deficit spend -\$1,023,565.63 this school year. The operational ending fund balance is now projected be 28.9%. This will most likely end higher than 28.9% due to unspent funds.
