### **Old Business**

Policy JG-R was approved. Starting in summer school, high school students will be able to wear hats and hoods from their hoodies on their heads while at school. Elementary and middle school students will continue to not to be able to wear hats and hoods at school.

### **New Business**

Due to the projected shortage of bus drivers next school year, the board of education approved a plan for teachers to be able to be bus drivers.

A contract with Edgenuity was approved. This will be the credit recovery system for the high school for the next three years. This will be paid out of ESSER II funds for a total of \$50,500.

An adjustment to the administrative salary schedule. The position "Alpha Principal" was removed and placed on the same step as the current "High School Assistant Principal."

Sarah Janes was selected to sit on the WISE Foundation Board as the second board member.
